






Earthquake – prepared by the U.S. Geological Survey, the map shows the KC area to be in relatively little threat of significant seismic activity.



Tornado – prepared by the National Severe Storm Lab, this map illustrates the total annual threat of tornadoes in the U.S. The mean number of days per year with one or more events within 25 miles of KC is 1.0 days.
